# Register at the clinic front desk. No appointment needed.

You should be fasting prior to your blood draw, but are encouraged to drink plenty of water.

Insurance will not be billed. You must pay at time of service.

### **Comprehensive Blood Test: \$60**

Measures your sugar (glucose) level, electrolyte and fluid balance, kidney function, and liver function. Also includes a lipid panel.

## **Prostate Specific Antigen: \$35**

Measures an antigenic enzyme released by the prostate and found in high concentrations in the blood of men with prostate cancer.

## **Thyroid Stimulating Hormone Test: \$35**

A thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH) blood test is used to check for thyroid gland problems.

## **Hemoglobin A1C: \$25**

This test tells you your average level of blood sugar over the past 2 to 3 months. The A1C test is also used to diagnose diabetes.

### Hemoglobin A1C & Microalbumin/Creatinine: \$45

A Microalbumin/Creatinine Urine Ratio test is used to detect any signs of kidney damage, usually caused by diabetes.

#### **Vitamin D Test: \$40**

Measures the level of Vitamin D in your blood to make sure you have enough to keep your bones healthy and your muscles, nerves, and immune system working normally.

#### **Spirometry Test: FREE**

Assesses how well your lungs work by measuring how much air you inhale, how much you exhale, and how quickly you exhale.
